James); No agreements waiving c/s arrearages (Marriage of M.); No forgiveness of excess childcare add-ons (Tavares); etc.
- > Spousal Support: Propriety of Richmond reductions (West); Effect of void marriage (Campbell); etc.
- ➤ **Community Property**: Overcoming c/p presumption (*Ettefagh*); Apportionment of wrongful death proceeds (*Corder*); etc.
- Attorney Fees: Waiving MFAA (Ervin, Cohen & Jessup); No 128.7 sanctions to pro per atty (Musaelian); Enforceability of binding arbitration clauses (Schatz v. Allen, Matkin, et al); Attorney fee liens (Cal-Western Reconveyance); Prevailing party fees (Estate of Drummond); 128.7 sanctions by juvenile ct. referee (Mark B.)
- Adoption: *Kelsey S.* requirements (*Arthur A*); etc.
- ➤ Interstate Custody: Cannot transfer jurisdiction if one party resides in CA (Stone v. Davis); Hague Convention (Forrest and Eaddy) (Papakosmas); UCCJEA (Sareen); etc.
- **Employment Benefits**: Division of military disability pay (*Smith*); etc.
- Parentage: No parentage by estoppel (Arzaga); Qualifying as presumed father (Said); etc.
- Family Residence: No constructive notice from *lis pendens (Dyer v. Martinez*); etc.
- ➤ **Procedure Before Trial**: 170.6 challenge (*Bravo*); etc.
- Procedure After Trial: Memo of Decision appealable order (Arzaga); Appeal from bifurcated issue (Lafkas)
- Professional Responsibility: Atty client privilege (Reiserer); Cannot sue joint expert (Ramalingam); etc.
- **Domestic Violence**: Continuing tort doctrine and statute of limitations (*Pugliese*), etc.
- Litigation Privilege trumps privacy privilege (Jacob B.)
- ➤ **Domestic Partners**: Only one bankruptcy exemption (Rabin and Johnson); etc.
- ➤ Income Tax Matters: Taxability of *Gilmore* payments (*Dunkin*); Modification of judgment and IRC §1041 (Private Letter Ruling 200709014); Taxability and character of employment retaliation judgment (*Green*); E.I.C. for murderer (*Rone*); etc.
- > New Legislation.
